To be Given at the New Girls' Orphan Asylum.

At St. Patrick's Girls' Orphan Asylum on Clifton street Sunday afternoon, the ladies and gentlemen, who had charge of the big fair for its benefit a year ago, held a meeting and made arrangement for a public reception at the new institution, so that the people may have opportunity to see the results of their generosity.

Over 300 were present. Among those who attended the meeting were Very Rev. J. F. O'Hare of the Immaculate Conception church, Rev. J. J. Leary of Corpus Christi church and Rev. J. P. Kieran of the Cathedral. D. C. Feeley was chosen chairman and Mrs. J. B. O'Connor secretary of the meeting.

It was decided to hold the proposed reception at the asylum from 2 until 8 p. m. on Thanksgiving day and to give opportunity for any donations to the purposes of the asylum. This will be the formal opening of the institution. Miss Julia Cox was chosen treasurer of the fund.

MGR. SATOLLI.

VISIT OF THE APOSTOLIC DELEGATE TO ROCHESTER.

Mgr. Satolli, whose coming to Rochester was mentioned last week, arrived in this city from Buffalo by the 11.15 o'clock train on the Central Friday.

The visitor was accompanied by Rev. Dr. Edward J. Hanna, of the faculty of St. Bernard's Seminary, who met Mgr. Satolli in Buffalo, where both attended the exercises held in celebration of Bishop Ryan's twenty-fifth anniversary. Rev. Dr. Quigley, rector of the Buffalo Cathedral, and several other priests were also in the party. At the station the Delegate was met by Rev. J. P. Kieran, rector of the Cathedral, and a number of other priests.

Bishop McQuaid cordially welcomed the visitor, who was driven in a carriage drawn by four horses from the Central railroad station directly to the episcopal residence on Frank street. There was an informal reception, at which the priests of the Cathedral and the professors of St. Bernard's seminary were presented to the delegate. There was a drive about the western part of the city, giving the visitor opportunity to inspect the church and school buildings of the Cathedral, St. Peter and Paul's, Holy Family and Immaculate Conception parishes; also Nazareth Convent and Academy, St. Mary's hospital, St. Patrick and St. Mary's orphan asylums.

Dinner followed at Bishop McQuaid's table. Mgr. Satolli expressed himself as especially pleased to meet some of his former pupils, who had studied in his classes while they were attending the American college at Rome. They are Rev. Fathers Hanna, Harrington, Mochas, Breen and McGuire. Revs. Miller and Staub were also present.

After dinner there was a drive on the east side of the river, when the Sacred Heart academy, Convent of Mercy and the church and school buildings of St. Joseph's St. Michael's, St. Bridget's, St. Mary's, St. Boniface and Holy Redeemer parishes were viewed.

St. Bernard's Seminary was visited last, and there Mgr. Satolli was received with the ceremonies usual on parish visitations. The visitor, who had worn an ordinary black morning suit, here donned his clerical robes and the exercises were held in the seminary chapel, at which all the students were present. Addresses were delivered by the students in Latin and English, welcoming the visitor.

Friday night Mgr. Satolli remained at the seminary. He celebrated mass there Saturday morning, after which he proceeded to Baltimore, where he had promised to celebrate mass Sunday morning. On account of that engagement he was compelled to decline Bishop McQuaid's invitation to remain in Rochester over Sunday, which would have given an opportunity for a more formal reception.

The Episcopal residence on Frank street was gaily decorated with American and Papal flags. There were similar decorations at Nazareth and Sacred Heart academies, at both of which institutions Mgr. Satolli made brief visits.

At Nazareth academy the students sang the "Vivat," after which Miss Kittle O'Connor delivered an address in English, welcoming the visitor and expressing the love and loyalty of the pupils for Pope Leo and his representatives. Mgr. Satolli responded in Italian, thanking the pupils for their hearty reception and congratulating them on the evidence of progress in their studies. He also spoke in commendation of Catholic education. The address was translated into English to the pupils by Dr. Hanna. The Convent orchestra played a selection after which the delegate gave his blessing to the pupils.

Rev. Dr. James F. O'Hare was among the guests at the dinner at the Episcopal residence; also Rev. Dr. Sinclair.
