ative Samuel Ross, the speaker's secre

tary, was in a carriage and received a

great ovation.

Labor's Day in Montreal.

MONTREAL, Sept. 4.—Labor day was

celebrated at usual here with processions

and picnics. The big procession took

hour to pass a given point. One of the

features which caused much remark was

a red anarchist flag. There were no dis

turbances.

skirts.

600 men being in line.

and in Providence 2,500 men participated

in the biggest similar celebration ever held

here.
