CONNAUGHT. LEINSTER.

GALWAY. The Clifton Railway will be completed.

It is announced that the Countess of Clancarty will shortly appear again before the public on the musical stage.

The Lord Lieutenant has appointed to the office of High Sheriff of Galway County, Major R. Galbraith, Cappard Loughrea.

LEITRIM. John Hosie, Esq., Dromabaire, has been appointed High Sheriff of Leitrim.

As District-Inspector Kerin, of Carrick-on-Shannon, was out riding recently, near the town, his horse fell, and threw him heavily on the road.

MAYO. Major-General W. B. Saunders-Knox Gore, Belleek Manor, Ballina, has been appointed High Sheriff of Mayo, for 1895.

In the chapel of the Sacred Heart attached to the Convent of Mercy, Castlebar, Very Rev. P. Lyons, P.P., performed the interesting ceremony of receiving to the Holy Habit Miss Johanna Kneeshaw, fourth daughter of W. Kneeshaw, Esq., Clonmel.

WEXFORD. A second serious case of smallpox in Enniscorthy Union is reported.

The first was that of a man named Doyle, who is now convalescent, and who caught the infection in Dublin, and it appears that, while he was in the Fever Hospital at Enniscorthy, a child named Collier, who was there under treatment for scarlatina, came in contact with him, and, as it had never been vaccinated, caught the disease.

WICKLOW. A sad fatality occurred near the goods station of Dublin, Wicklow, and Wexford Railway Company, at Wicklow, recently.

MUNSTER. CLARE. Mr. Francis Vandelaar Westby, of Gurtalougha, Borrisokane, county Tipperary, has been appointed High Sheriff of Clare, for the year 1895.

CORK. Mr. Henry Lindsay Young, of Leemount, Carrigrohane, has been appointed High Sheriff of Cork County.

A number of counterfeit Bank of Ireland one pound notes have been circulated in Fermoy recently. The counterfeit, which appears at first sight to be a rather blurred copper-plate print, is in reality a carefully executed pen and ink transfer of a genuine note.

KERRY. The man Myers, of Listry, near Killarney, who recently attempted suicide by cutting his throat with a razor, died in the workhouse infirmary a few days ago.

LIMERICK. At the Limerick City Petty Sessions, Percival Atkins, a jeweller, of respectable position, was charged with an assault on Mr. R. H. Dyer, Veterinary Surgeon, on the 11th of October last.

TIPPERARY. Mr. Gleeson, solicitor, of Nenagh, has been appointed Crown Solicitor of Tipperary.

Mr. Robert Malcomson, of Melview, Clonmel, has been appointed High Sheriff of Tipperary.

WATERFORD. Mr. Chas. Edward Denny, of May Park, has been appointed High Sheriff of the county.

The Examiners into proofs of compliance with the 'standing orders' in Parliament resumed their sittings at Westminster recently, when the Waterford and Limerick Railway Bill, which, among other things, empowers the company to change its name to 'The Irish Great Western Company,' and to raise further money, was found to have complied with the standing orders and was ordered to be reported for first reading.

ULSTER. ANTRIM. A patent has been issued to J. Press, of Dunmurry, near Belfast, for an invention for 'improvements in machines in spinning flax, hemp, tow, or other similar fibres.'

ARMAGH. The agent of the Duke of Manchester (Mr. Atkinson, Tenderagee,) has given notice to the tenants on the Duke of Manchester's county Armagh estate, comprising four townlands, that if they pay their rent, due 1st November last, on or before 1st March next, they will be allowed 10 per cent of a reduction.

DERRY. John Cooke, Esq., Foyle View, Derry, has been appointed High Sheriff of Derry City and County.

DONEGAL. Henry Chichester Hart, Esq., Carrablagh, Portsalon, Letterkenny, has been appointed High Sheriff of Donegal.

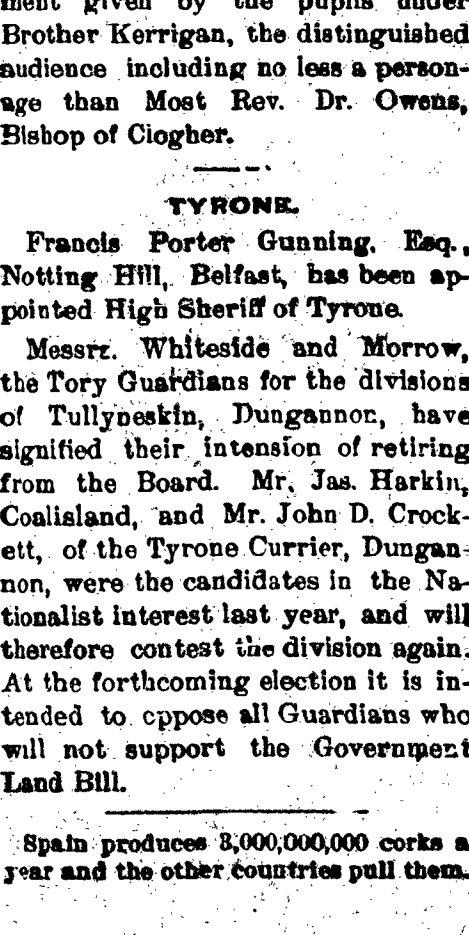
DOWN. An epidemic of small-pox has broken out among a number of mill operatives in Newry, but so far it has been confined to prescribed districts.
