This was not carried out at the time. but was accomplished four years later, by President Juarez, who established Gaute street through the cometery of the monastery and drove out all the priests. Junes destroyed the alters, took down the bells from the towers and otherwise made ineffective the traditions of the place

The lewels and pictures were removed to other places for rest, and the main entrance to the structure closed by the erection of a row of residences on the western side. The massive pile was left to darkness and decay and was used for many alien purposes at different times.
