NATIONAL FINANCES

Public Debt, Receipts and Expenditures and Other Statements

WASHINGTON, Dec. 2

The statement of the public debt shows that on Nov. 30, the debt in the treasury, amounting to \$255,789,150, an increase for the month of \$2,702,923.

This increase is accounted for by a corresponding decrease in the amount of cash on hand.

The debt is recapitulated as follows: Interest bearing debt, \$247,364,520; debt on which interest has ceased since maturity, \$1,501,630; debt bearing no interest, \$6,922,999; total, \$1,255,897,639.

This, however, does not include \$507,529,322 in certificates and treasury notes outstanding which are offset by an equal amount of cash in the treasury.

The cash in the treasury is recapitulated as follows, cents omitted: Gold, \$109,557,101; silver, \$28,654,450; paper, \$129,018,155; bonds, debentures and other securities, \$17,137,872; total, \$285,367,578.

LATEST CUBAN RUMORS

Is Uncle Sam About to S: Spain's Hand?

WAR TALK IN WASHINGTON

Secretary Olney Reported to Have Issued a Warning Note to the Spaniards—Congress May Soon Take a Very Firm Stand.

WASHINGTON, Dec. 3.—Reports are in quite general circulation here to the effect that Secretary Olney, some time in November, had given the Spanish government courteously, but finally to understand that the Cuban rebellion must be crushed within three months on the United States would be compelled to intervene to stop hostilities.

It was said that prominent Republican senators have been informed of this ultimatum.
