When Buying Onions.

Take these same onions grown in this country, and they degenerate inwhat the Spanish onion is-big and as apples, deliciously sweet and not

too pungent in flavor. There are over one hundred ways or are when eaten raw. Thanks to some of the unscrupulous dealers in town, we are not getting as many of these luscious Spanish onions as in former seasons. One can make more money selling a domestic onion called the Prize Winner, which all over town is of young girls. The Lowest Wages.



In the candy factories of Atlanta something over 500 women and girls are employed. Their hours are from 7 A. M. until 5.30 P. M. They average about \$3 per week. Their work is light, and in the main done under tairly sanitary conditions.

Here the saleswomen in the best shops average from \$3 to \$3.50 per week, working nine hours a day.
