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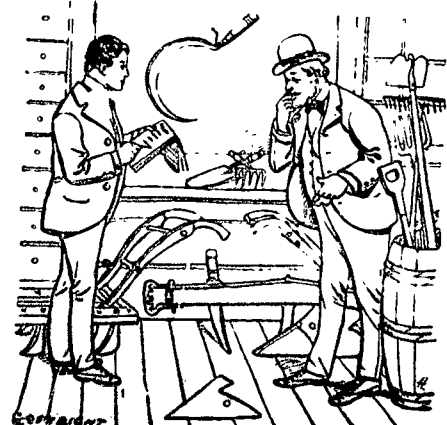
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### Spring Work.

Can't be delayed. It's time to get a full supply of tools for sowing and planting. Time and labor are doubly worth saving. Reduce work and time required for it, to a minimum by using improved implements that rob gardening of its drudgery and make it a pleasure.

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To Restore Flowers to Freshness. Faded flowers, if not too far gone, may be restored to freshness by this simple process. Place the stems in water near boiling point, and let the flowers remain till the shriveled petals begin to spread out. Then cut off the stems and put in lukewarm water.

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St. John's College.  
Rev. Father John J. Collins, D. J., has been appointed president of St. John's college, Fordham, N. Y. Father Collins for several years has been doing missionary duty after returning to this country following several years work in Kingston, Jamaica. Father Collins is a native of Kentucky, about forty-seven years of age and heretofore has held no important offices in the order. His appointment to the presidency of Fordham college came as a surprise. The Rev. George A. Pettitt, the former president, has been sent to St. Andrews on the Hudson, where the Jesuit order has recently built a large novitiate. While it has not been officially announced, it is generally understood that Father Pettitt will be made superior of the novitiate, which is considered one of the highest honors in the order.
