Catholic Notes

Cardinal Gibbons and a number of other men in Pennsylvania, Maryland and New York have formed a company for the purpose of obtaining information concerning the practices and conditions of every kind that are dangerous to public health. It is proposed in this line to assist the authorities in the prosecution of fakirs and all who impose on the public by selling narcotics and dangerous mixtures under the guise of medicines. This is a stroke against some forms of patent medicines known to contain alcohol, cocaine, digitalis and other ingredients not conducive to health and of themselves possessing no medicinal value.

It is rumored that a number of prominent Catholic ladies in Covington and Newport, Kentucky, intend to organize a branch of the Society of the Daughters of the Faith. This society was established a few years ago in New York by prominent Catholic ladies of that city, under the auspices of the Most Rev. Archbishop Farley, for the purposes of uplifting society, and especially to protest against the evil of divorce. Doubtless the Kentucky branch of the society is intended more as a preventive than a cure, since the sins of society are not flourishing below the Mason and Dixon line.

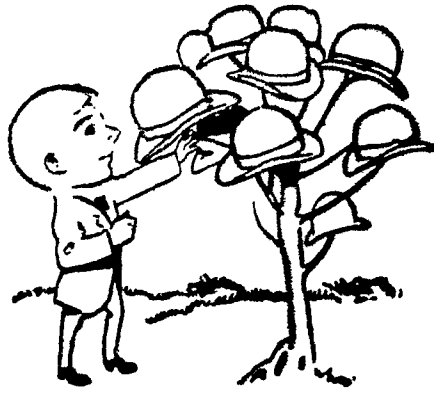
