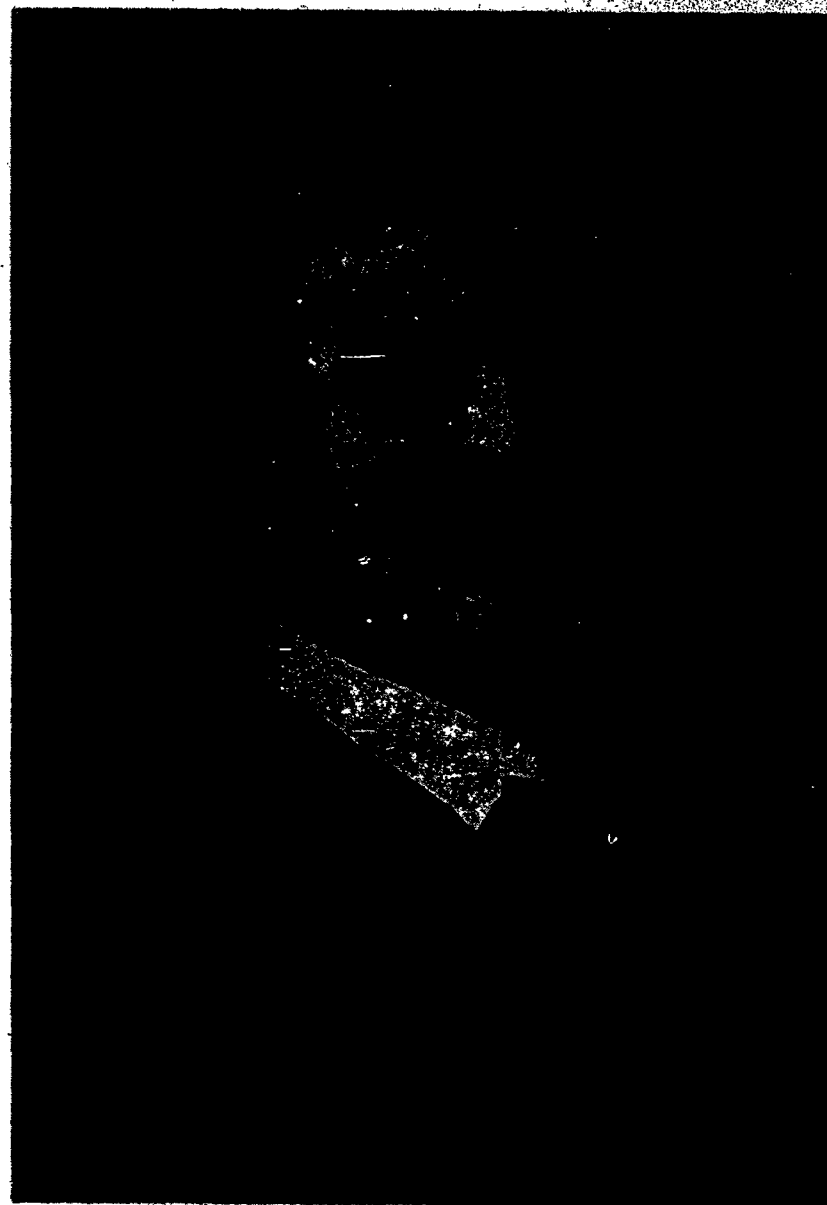

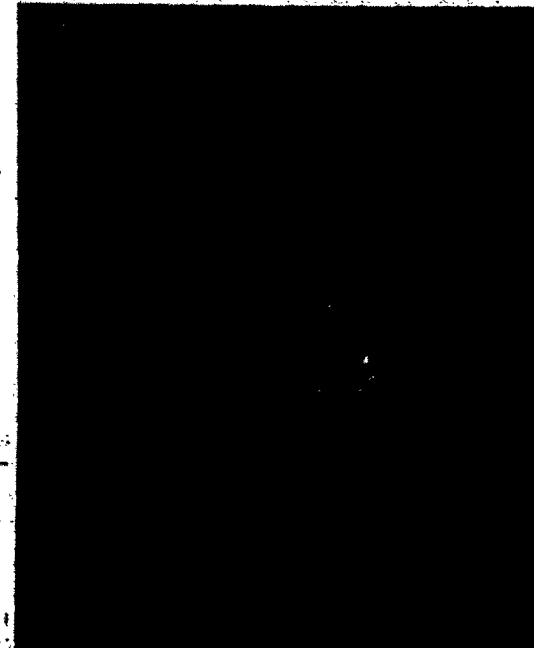
Edwin Augustus Fisher,

HENRY W. MORSE

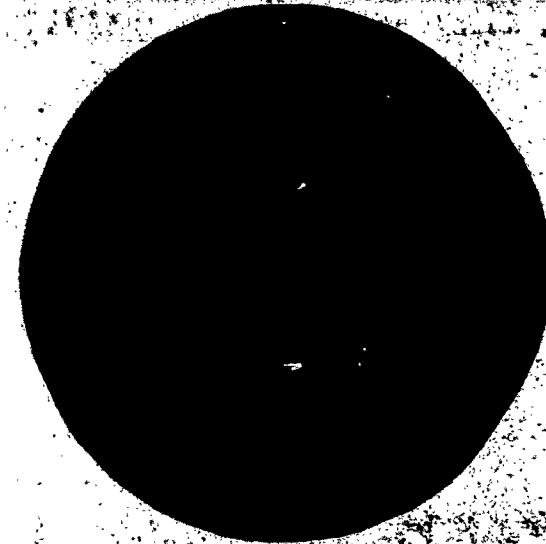
