The business originated with F. L. Griswold in 1838. He died in 1870, when the firm became Barker, Griswold & Co. Justin L. Barker died in 1904, when the proprietorship passed to the present firm, consisting of C. P. Mosher, C. L. Griswold and G. F. Eldred. This firm employs more than 50 helpers, mostly male, and as it does a large share of its own manufacturing, and thus saves jobbers' profits, it is able to sell at low figures. The business plan of the house is to depend on volume of trade, rather than on large profits.
