The eastern band of Vincentian missionaries, on its fifth round of missions for the year, is engaged in St. Joseph's Church, Cambridge Falls, N. Y. St. Leo's, Danbury, Conn. St. Francis, West Mass., St. Helena's and the Presentation, Brooklyn, and St. Thomas Aquinas Philadelphia.

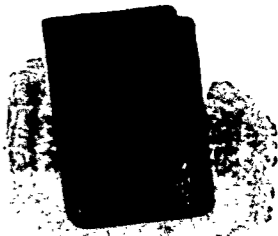

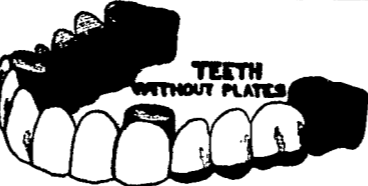
