Cardinal Satolli Dead.

Was the First Apostolic Delegate to the United States—A Great Theologian, Churchman and Diplomat.

Rome Jan. 8. Francesco Satolli one of the five cardinal bishops of the Catholic Church died at 8 o'clock this morning after a three-week illness of nephritis. Cardinal Satolli was 71 years old and was raised to the cardinalate in 1895. He was Prefect of congregational studies at the time of his death.



Cardinal Satolli. The Pope was greatly distressed by the death of Cardinal Satolli, one of the most notable figures of the Roman Church. He was born in the town of Poggia on March 21, 1837. His first visit to the United States was in 1882 on the occasion of the Congress of the Holy See in 1882.

He was returned to the first Apostolic Delegate position which he held on the occasion of his appointment as apostolic delegate in 1895.
