Hasn't Got His Yet. "There is an average of about one cow to every five persons in the United States," said the boarding house lady.

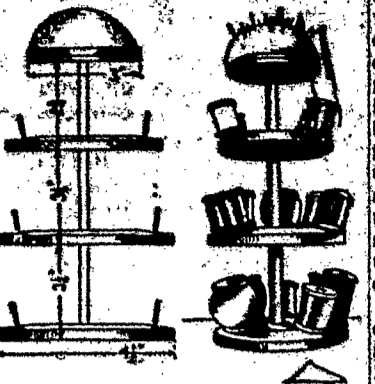

HINTS FOR THE BUSY HOUSEWIFE

Ornamental Finishing and Spool Holder.



An ornamental as well as a useful article for the sewing room is shown in the accompanying sketch. When made up and finished in the wood the same as the other furnishings of the room it will have a neat appearance.

Pieces of Dried Peas. Allow a pint of dry peas to soak overnight—about four hours—before dinner drain the cold water off and put the peas into a saucepan with two quarts of water.

Cleaning Old Brass. A recommended mixture which is suited to old brass or copper can be made of rotten stone, three-fourths of a pound being made into a powder with three-fourths of an ounce of gum arabic, an ounce of oxalic acid, an ounce and a half of sweet oil and sufficient water to make a paste.

Household Helps. Vegetables will take longer to cook, but will be much nicer and of better color, if boiled uncovered.

Conservation. When certain things do not see to be worth the trouble of repairing, so maybe you can save what one Self Providence R. J.

Spanish Cream. Dissolve half a box of gelatin in a little warm water. Put one and a half pints of milk in a double boiler, beat the yolks of three eggs with two-thirds of a cup of sugar, add to the milk and boil for a few minutes, then add the gelatin. Take from the fire and stir in the beaten whites of four eggs and put into a mold, and when cold serve with whipped cream.

Chasing Paint. To clean paint or other woodwork out a tablespoonful of kerosene, all in two-thirds of a pint of warm water and use no soap. This is excellent also for washing windows, although a little more kerosene may be used for glass.

Cornmeal Grits. Two eggs, one pint of sour milk, one tablespoonful of soda, salt, a little flour and cornmeal enough for a thin batter.

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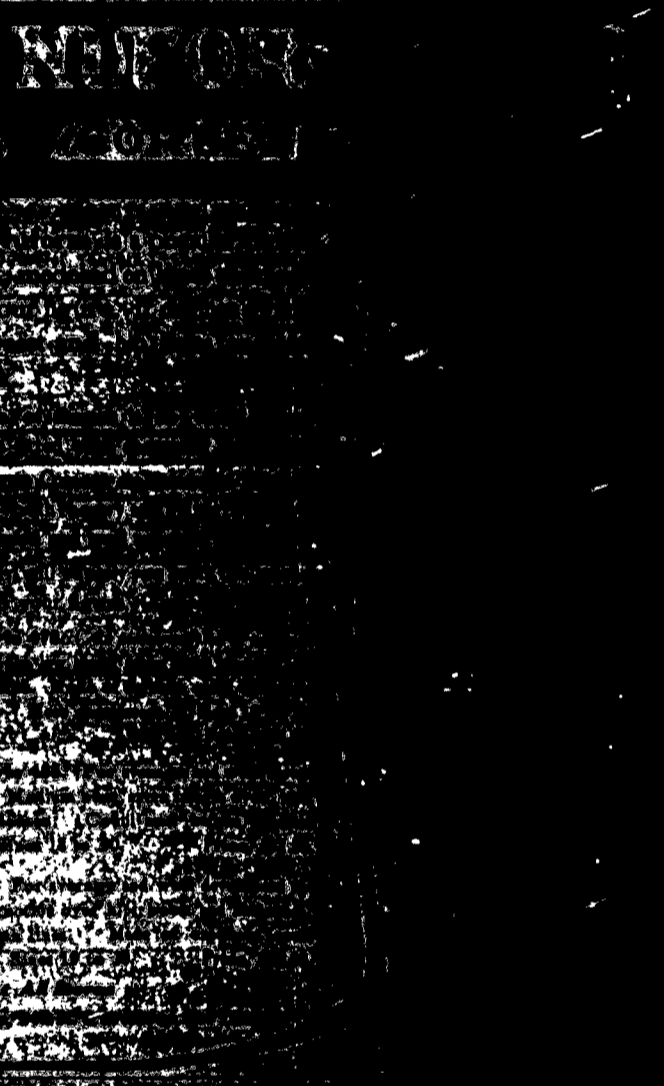
