Patience—And you say she left you college? "Patience—Oh, yes! You know, she was tongue tied, and she could never hope to use our college yell."—Yonkers Statesman.

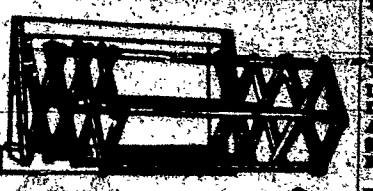

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HINTS FOR THE BUSY HOUSEWIFE

Folding Wall Rack For Drying Clothes.



During the winter months the housewife after she has done her laundry finds it very difficult to dry the wash during inclement weather.

The rack is assembled by using round sticks of wood one-half inch in diameter. As these serve to hold the hanging strips together and also to hold the clothes upon, they must be the length of the entire rack.

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Cream together one cupful of sugar and one-half cupful of butter. Add one salt spoonful of salt, one-half teaspoonful of cloves, one teaspoonful of cinnamon, a little nutmeg and one cupful seeded raisins.

Put a pint of peeled mushrooms into a small saucepan with a few slices of fat bacon or a lump of butter, just as you prefer.

Washing Black Cotton Goods. To wash any black cotton dress goods do not rub the soap on, but make a good suds and wash carefully with the hands.

Two cupfuls molasses, one-half cupful butter, one large spoonful ginger. Let boil five minutes. Dissolve two teaspoonfuls soda in a dish in one-half cupful water and pour the hot mixture on it.
