Expert Testimony. "I don't see why you women always want a house full of closets," remarked a husband to his wife.

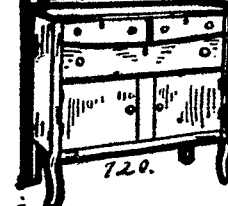
