Different. The Manager—I can't use your new comedy. It is too long. The Playwright—But it is as broad as it is long.

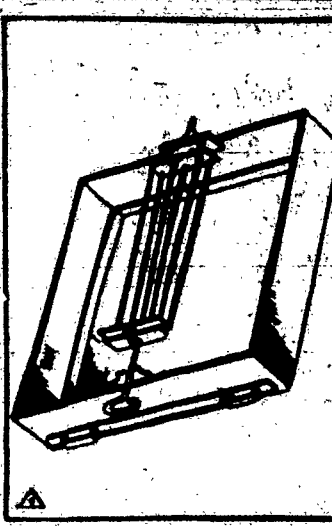

HINTS FOR THE BUSY HOUSEWIFE

New Broiling Apparatus For Use In Gas Stoves.
