Right Stand.

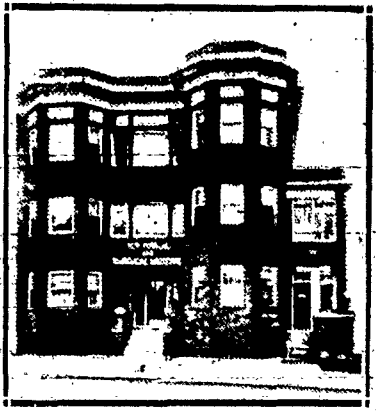
