What to Do For Insect Bites

The most common bites of stings are those of the bee, wasp, yellow jacket, spider, horse fly, yellow fly, red bug or buggier, then mosquitos and bedbugs.

First thing to do, of course, is to remove the sting. This can best be done with the point of a knife or needle but care should be taken not to break the skin for fear of infection.

In the case of bites, as well as of stings, when the sting is removed, as a rule, a paste of common baking soda applied to the affected parts or those bathed in ammonia water is all that is necessary.

An application of a 50 per cent solution of a saturated solution of potassium permanganate, which you get at the drug store, is very efficient for insect poisons and for the poisons of plants, too, such as poison ivy and such.

Use a rather heavy iron for pressing. Press slowly. Lift and place the iron bearing down heavily.

Decapitation. For ONE, which flows from tropic trees, Men brave the stings of southern seas.

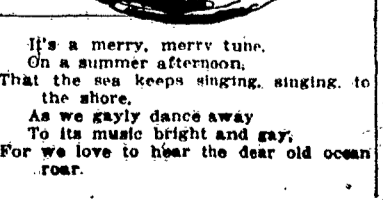
