How to Remove Grease Spots From Fabrics.

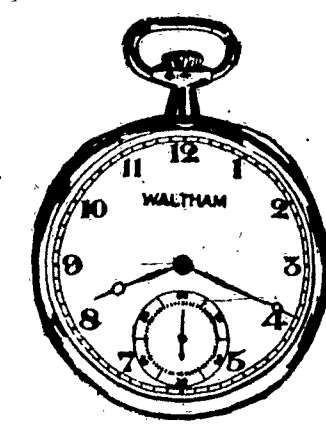
Spread one teaspoonful of butter evenly on the spot and let it remain there until the grease has become thoroughly soft.

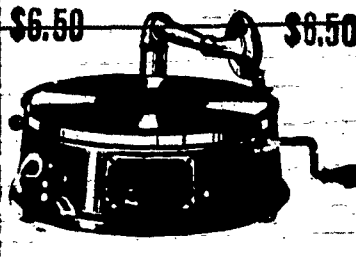
