## EXPOSITION OPENS MONDAY Monsignor Kennedy Is Dead In Rome.

With Many New Novelties, Shows and Amusements.

Jean Domenjos, a noted Swiss aviator will loop the loop in a monoplane and do other hair-raising feats each afternoon at the Exposition next week, and a giant Midway and sensational open air performances will supply the amusement end of the show.

The more serious features will include exhibits of modern defense equipment loaned by the Army and Navy departments, patriotic ensemble concerts by massed bands each evening, Industrial displays and processes of manufactures, a flower show, dog and poultry shows, New York State exhibits, a zoo and aviary, a collection of fine art and other exhibits.

A leading feature of the Exposition will be the Horse Show, which has attained the reputation of being the biggest and most successful outdoor affair of its kind held anywhere in the country, and in which will be seen 300 or more prize winning and blue ribbon animals in competitions for trophies and prizes.

### Italian War Pictures to Open Season at the Avon Theater Labor Day.

Not since the great world war began, it is declared, have such remarkable motion pictures of the fighting been taken as those comprising "The Italian Battle Front," the big ten-reel film that will be shown all next week in the Avon Theater, beginning on Monday, Labor Day.

It had been planned by Manager William B. McCallum to open the Avon as usual with stage offerings, but he could not ignore the unexpected opportunity to bring the Italian war pictures to Rochester. He is confident that they will arouse as much enthusiasm here as they have elsewhere, especially when people realize that they are genuine views of actual fighting taken at great hazards by the Italian governments own camera men.

Beginning on Monday, September 17, the Avon will have a preliminary season of popular price "road" attractions, following which the house will return to its regular vaudeville policy.

### American Prelate One of Most Prominent of Catholic Churchmen.

Rome, Aug. 30.—Monsignor Thomas F. Kennedy, rector of the American College in Rome, is dead after a long illness.

The Rt. Rev. Thomas F. Kennedy, Bishop of Adrianapolis and rector of the American College in Rome, was the foremost representative of the United States at the court of the Vatican.

Bishop Kennedy was born near Conshohocken, Pa., in 1857, his father being a quarry man. He began the study of theology in St. Charles Theological Seminary, Overbrook, and after two years there in which he showed brilliance in classical studies, he was sent to Rome. This was in 1881. Youthful and American in spirit, young Kennedy was greatly impressed by the lives of the grave and powerful prelates who formed the various congregations and determined to utilize his opportunity to the best advantage.

At the age of 24 years he was ordained a priest in Rome, and later he received the degree of Doctor of Divinity. He then returned to take the chair of theology in St. Charles Seminary, where his labors made him one of the most prominent educators in the country. His work attracted the attention of the pope, who called him to Rome to take charge of the American College there in 1900. He passed through the gradations of rank in the church until in 1907 he was made Bishop of Adrianapolis, to which office no diocese is attached.

A few years ago the bishop's father and mother died within a month of each other. These blows affected him greatly. He returned to America to visit his old home at Conshohocken and had been there but a short time when he became ill. He recovered and returned to Rome.

Bishop Kennedy carried his 60 years with a bearing that would give credit to a man of 30. His voice was soft, resonant, and possessed great capacity for expression. His hair was almost snow white.

It was to Bishop Kennedy that every American visitor to Rome who wished to have an audience with the pope was obliged to go. As rector of the American College he brought that remarkable institution to a high point of efficiency.
