Cabbage Ormet.—Take two cupfuls of hot cooked cabbage add a tablespoonful of drippings and a fourth of a cupful of cream.

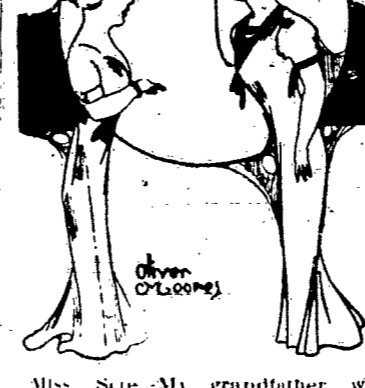
Savory Irish Fritters.—Soak a pound of stale crusts of bread in cold water, squeeze dry and chop.
