WESLEY IS FIGHTING MAD

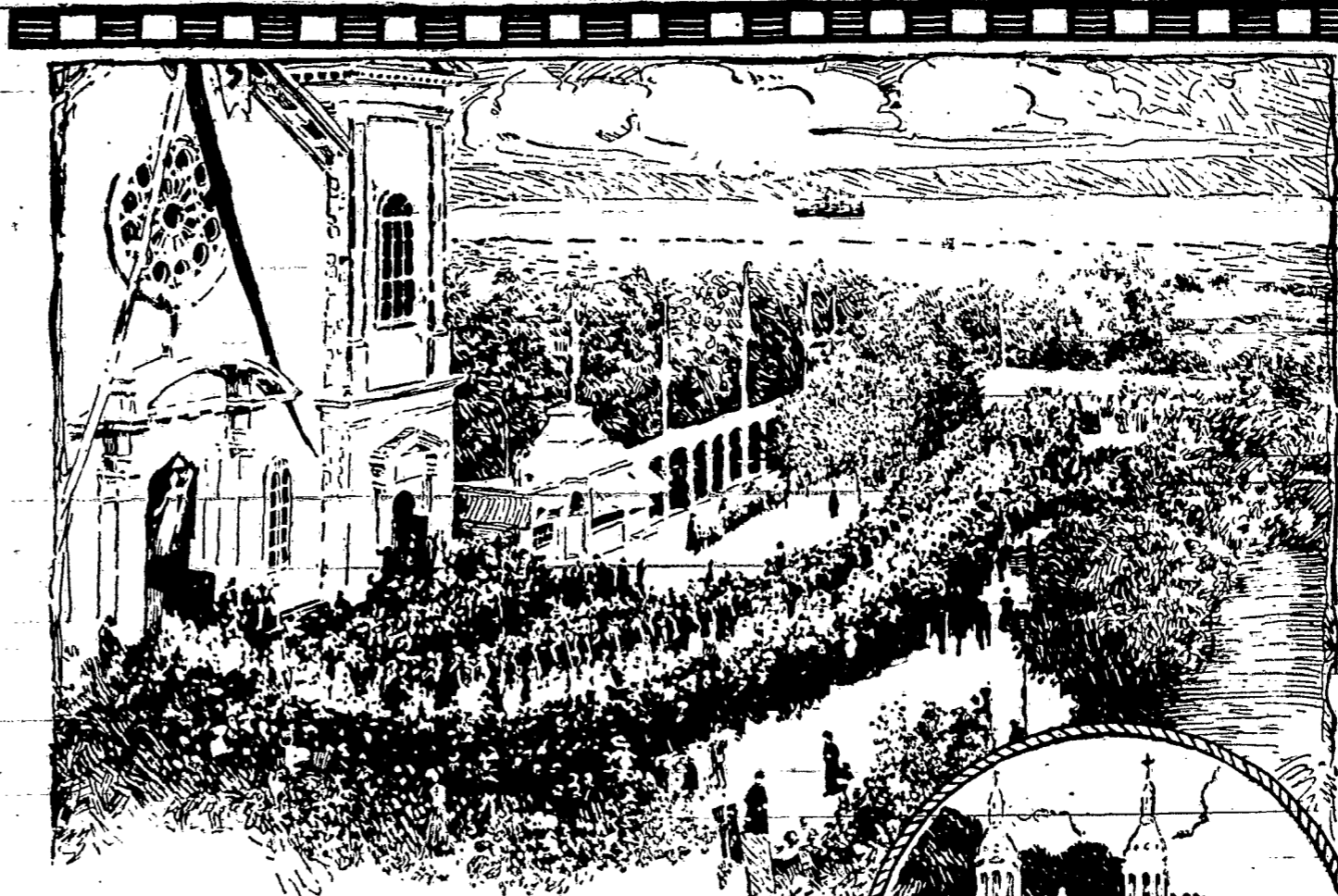
Because He Was Rejected by Marines on Account of Defective Teeth.

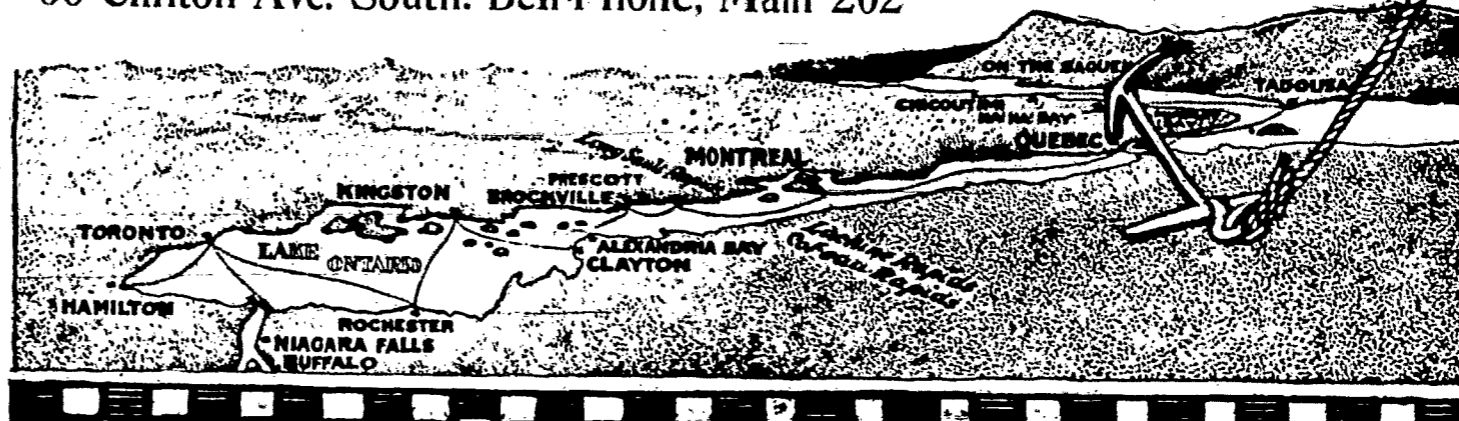

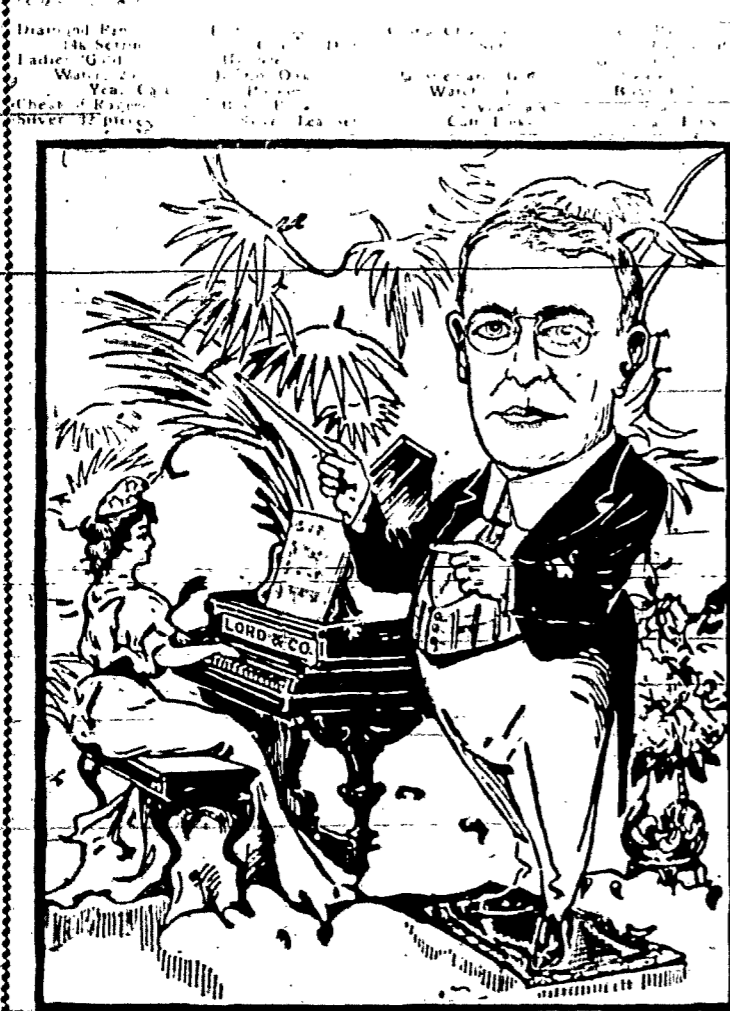

Raise Mint and Parsley.

Start a little mint in an out-of-the-way corner. It is very handy and will live on for 5 or 6 years. You will find it a welcome addition to cocktails, lemonade and to fruit tea. Add to lemon ice, it, both colors and flavors. It also will furnish material for mint sauce to serve with lamb and poultry. Parsley too should be planted. You will find use for it every day for garnishing and also for flavoring soups and cottage cheese.

Yield of Tomatoes.

The average yield of tomatoes in the United States last year is placed at about four tons to the acre, according to Farm Life. Nearly 1,000,000 tons of tomatoes were "manufactured"—that is, canned and made into catsup, etc. Canneries are offering \$15 to \$18 the ton for tomatoes this season.

Stop Combination Sales.

"Combination sales" are forbidden under a new ruling of the Massachusetts food administration. "Combination sales" are, according to the definition of the food administration, any sales of two or more commodities, of different kinds or sizes, at a price of five cents only, if they are bought at the same time.

Oil Cleans Wood.

A small quantity of olive oil applied to a wet cloth from which most of the water has been wrung furnishes an excellent cleanser for fine wood. The surface of the furniture should be rubbed with the cloth and then dried thoroughly with a soft, dry rag.

May 21 is the anniversary of the landing of Ferdinand de Soto in Florida in 1539. He thought he was on the path to a fabled fountain, by bathing in which he would regain his lost youth. Instead he found only morasses and impassable swamps.

Costly Law Proceedings.

The folly of rushing to the law to settle every little dispute is demonstrated by an action between two pottery makers for a sum of £2. After being in court for 11 years it was put an end to by being referred to arbitrators, who decided in favor of the defendant in the case, and ordered the plaintiff to pay all the costs incurred in the proceedings, which were assessed at £1,000.—London Tit-Bits.

Dead Locusts Valuable.

Locusts are plentiful in England, and the farmers of that republic are compelled to keep up a constant war against them. Millions of these destructive insects are killed every year. Recently it was learned that soap, fertilizer and lubricating oil may be obtained from the dead locusts, and in the future they will be utilized for that purpose.—Popular Science Monthly.
