WOUNDS CAUSE A HOW RISE OF TEMPER. ATURE IN PLANT-FAMILY .-It appears from some experiments made in Washington that when plants are wounded their respiration increases and at the same time their temperature perceptibly rises as if a kind of fever had been produced by the

wound. A thérmoelectric apparatus capable of registering a change of one four-hundredth of a degree was employed. When a potato was wounded the fever manifested itself by an elevation of temperature which was greatest at the end of 24 hours. when it began slowly to decline.

An onion similarly treated acquired an increase of tempera ture many times greater than that shown by the potato, and the fever instead of being confined to the neighborhood of the wound affected the whole onion. In fact, the onion proved to be more readily affected in this way than any other vegetable experimented with.

The rise of temperature is caused by increased absorption of oxygen.
