The funeral of Miss Margaret Fouquet, aged 34 years took place Saturday morning at 9 o'clock.

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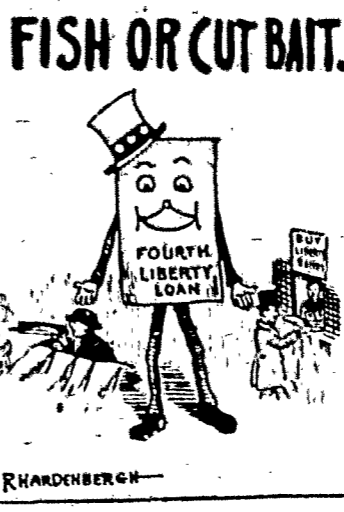
