Bishop Muldoon Is Said To Have Been Appointed Archbishop of St. Paul.

St. Paul, Dec. 16. - Bishop Peter J. Muldoon of the archdiocese of Chicago is said to have been appointed Archbishop of St. Paul, to succeed the late Archbishop Ireland.

Father James C. Byrne, vicar general of the diocese of St. Paul and administrator to fill the vacancy until a successor to Archbishop Ireland is named, said that he has heard nothing official about Bishop Muldoon's appointment. Dispatches from Rockford, Ill., said Bishop Muldoon declined to either deny or confirm the report.

The Rev. Superintendent of the parochial schools of the diocese of Cleveland has recommended that the 700 Sisters engaged in teaching those schools receive an increase in the meager compensation heretofore allotted them for their work in the school. The increase will be about \$5 a month.

In Rome has been introduced the Cause of Beatification of the Servant of God, Father James Desire Laval Apostle of Mauritius in the years 1803-1864.

The Palatine Hill is the oldest of the seven hills of Rome. On it Romulus built his strong, straight wall enclosing a four-sided space, about 2,650 years ago. Romulus' burial place was discovered not very long ago in the Roman Forum.

Mgr. August Declercq, of the Schuet Missions, Belgium, has been appointed Bishop of the Congo Vicariate of Kasal.

The Borghese Chapel in the Church of St. Mary Major, in Rome, cost originally \$10,000,000.

Magnificent is the Church of St. Paul, about three miles outside of Rome. It is 400 feet long, 200 feet wide and to the ceiling, 75 feet high. The present St. Paul's was erected last century and was the finest built in that century. Two malachite altars in it cost \$100,000 each. The Czar of Russia presented them.

In Rome there is still used the great sewer built by Tarquin 2,400 years ago. It is still used in draining the city.

To the Austrian Government a proposal has been submitted for aviators to sprinkle salt on the clouds below them to cause rain in dry sections.

In London there is an institute called "Crusade of Rescue." It maintains nearly 1,000 Catholic boys and girls.

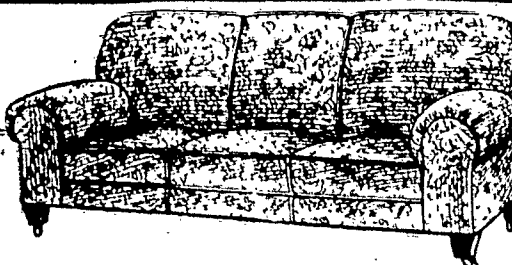
