Mrs. Frederick Cole Dies Suddenly

Mrs. Minnie Elizabeth Cole, 39, wife of Frederick A. Cole, of 420 Oxford street, died suddenly in her electric automobile on Stone street Monday afternoon. Mrs. Cole had been shopping. She suffered an attack of heart trouble when she returned to her car and was about to drive home. Clerks in the Alliance bank noticed her predicament and went to her aid. Coroner Killip had the remains removed to the family home by Mr. Cole, who was formerly superintendent of construction at Kodak Park.

Mrs. Cole leaves her husband, Frederick A. Cole, one sister, Frances Morris, and one brother, Walter J. Morris. The funeral was held on Thursday morning at 9:30 o'clock from the home and at 10 o'clock from Our Lady of Victory Church. Interment was made in the family lot in Holy Sepulcher Cemetery.

AID SOCIETY SEEKING HOMES

For Catholic Youngsters in City and Country.

The Children's Aid Society is in need of Catholic homes for children coming under its jurisdiction, protection and care, and Catholic families in the city and county willing to take children to board are requested to get in touch with Miss Mary R. Orwen, general secretary, Nos. 400-403 Livingston building, Rochester.

The society assumes the custody and guardianship of children in Monroe county turned over to it by the courts and the poor department. On December 1st the number of children in its care was 561 seven have been received in November. All these children are placed in private homes. The society is included in the Community Chest budget.
