Ireland Equipped For Freedom.

"Ireland is equipped for freedom and the only favor she asks is recognition from America" declared Leo A. MacSweeney, city chairman of the Irish Bond Drive, speaking at a meeting of ward workers in the campaign. "England has shut off Ireland from direct intercourse with the outside world, with the result that English middlemen secure not only double freight charges and commissions on Ireland's exports to imports from other countries, but all England controls Irish trade by the operation of British state departments, with great consequent loss to Ireland."

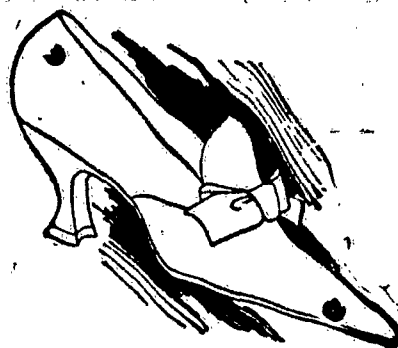
Mr. MacSweeney went on to tell how Ireland was well equipped to govern herself. He said: "While in the past two years the case of Ireland has been beclouded by a very clever propaganda of misrepresentation, now that the reaction is set in the true facts of the situation are daily becoming more apparent to the American people."

"The workers therefore need have no hesitancy in appealing for financial support from their fellow citizens for this great movement. Every phase of the present situation in Ireland is exactly parallel to the case of our own country in its early struggles for liberty. So again the appeal to every worker is work, work, and yet more work."
