### Impressive Funeral Services For Sister Florentine

Funeral services for Sister M. Florentine McCarthy, of the order of the Sisters of St. Joseph, who died last Saturday were held in the chapel of Nazareth Normal School on Tuesday morning. Solemn high mass of requiem was celebrated by the Rev. Wm. P. Ryan; Rev. J. Francis O'Hern, rector of the Cathedral, officiated as deacon; Rev. B. Quirk of Holy Rosary church, subdeacon, and Rev. M. Hynes of St. Boniface Church, master of ceremonies. A number of priests were present in the sanctuary.

Besides the family of Sister Florentine, Edmund D., Eugene J., Agnes and Winifred McCarthy and Mrs. Peter J. Munhall and other relatives, many friends came from Buffalo and Auburn to attend the funeral. The officers and a delegation of members represented the Alumnae Association of Nazareth Academy, of which Sister Florentine was a member, being also for years a member of the faculty of Nazareth Academy. Many other friends and former pupils were present. The music of the mass was beautifully sung by the excellently trained choir of the normal school.

As the funeral cortege left the normal school for Holy Sepulcher cemetery, it passed long lines of pupils of Nazareth Academy and of Nazareth Hall Academy, extending almost to the entrance to the cemetery grounds.

Interment was made in Holy Sepulcher cemetery. The services at the grave were conducted by the Rev. Dr. Charles E. Duffy, pastor of the new Cathedral at Buffalo, assisted by Rev. John John McMahon, chaplain at St. Ann's Home for the Aged and Rev. Edward Meagher of St. Bernard's Seminary. An impressive feature of this touching ceremony at the grave was the chanting of the Benedictus by the Sisters' Choir as the body was lowered into the grave.




