Tues. Aug. 23. - St. Philip Benizi, who was born in Florence, the Feast of the Assumption, 1233 the same day that the Order of Servites was founded.

Wed. Aug. 24. - St. Bartholomew, one of the twelve apostles, who carried the gospel into the remotest Indies. He was martyred in Great Armenia.

Thurs. Aug. 25. - St. Louis, King of France, the first, the best and the bravest of the Christian knights of the thirteenth century.

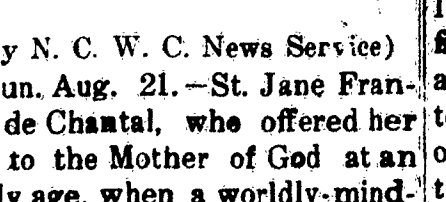
