To Take Bruises Out of Furniture. Oftentimes in moving furniture it gets bruised, leaving a dent or small hole. This dent or bruise can be easily raised to the surface again by wetting the part with warm water: double a piece of brown paper five or six times, sonk it in warm water, and lay it on the place; apply on that a warm, but not hot, flatiron, till the moisture is evaporated. If the bruise be not gone, repeat the process. After two or three applications the dent or bruise will be raised to the surface. 
