Cornerstone For New Summerville School To Be Laid Sunday

On Sunday afternoon at 3 o'clock Bishop Thomas F. Hickley assisted by Rev. John F. Muckie and neighboring priests will lay the cornerstone at St. Thomas Parochial School, Summerville Boulevard and Cole road.

The building will be of the most modern one-story type with a parish hall in the basement. It will be fifty-eight feet wide and 150 feet long when completed. At present only the front portion of the building will be erected. The exterior of the building will be of rough texture tapestry brick of grey, cream, brown, and light grey shades, with water-table and sills of cast stone colored to blend well with the brick.

With the new Seneca School, which was completed last fall, and the new St. Thomas School, which will be ready for use this fall, the rapidly increasing population of the Summerville and St. Paul boulevard districts will be provided with modern school facilities unsurpassed in any part of the state.

Commemorate First National Assembly In German Church

Cologne, June 11. — The seventy-fifth anniversary of the First National Assembly of the German people, celebrated recently at Frankfurt-on-the-Main had a particular interest for German Catholics because of the fact that both the National Assembly and the provisional assembly preparatory to it were held in St. Paul's Church.

The first conferences of the provisional assembly were held from March 31 to April 4, 1848, and, on May 18 of the same year, 548 deputies made their entrance in the church for the First National Assembly. The altar was covered with a veil and over the organ-loft was a painting of "Germania". Where the priest had previously taken his place to pronounce the blessing over the congregation was the seat of the President of the Assembly. The pulpit was the tribune for the assembly and in the tangle sat the deputies and the spectators.

St. Paul's Church was erected in 1833 and is of the new Roman style. It stands close to the old town hall, where, in medieval times the German King was elected, the Bishops of Cologne, Trier and Mainz being among those who cast their votes. After the election a great banquet took place in honor of the new king, who was conducted from Frankfurt to Aix-la-Chapelle, where he was crowned by the Archbishop of Cologne.

St. Paul's Church was given back to divine service in 1862.

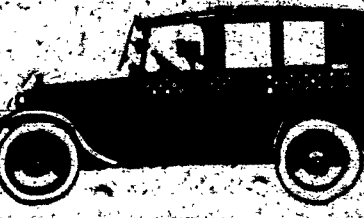
