REFRIGERATION IDEA REVERSED
 Method of Saving Ice Now Used to Save Heat in Latest Type of Range

The principle of insulation used for years in the saving of cold in a refrigerator is now being applied to the saving of heat. By means of the latest type of gas range, it is possible to cook for hours after the gas is turned off. This newest development of culinary science, known as the Chambers Fireless Gas Range, is now being sold by Matt, Bareham & McFarland, 366 Main street East.

In most respects, it is like any good gas range, but with the important exception of two special patented features that enable it to utilize the principle of cooking on "retained heat." One of these known as the "Thermodom," is a device whereby boiling may be done with only a few minutes' burning of gas. It is a dome shaped hood, heavily insulated, which is suspended by a chain over the top of the range and is easily operated by a convenient lever. It employs the retained heat principle for cooking vegetables, stews, cereals, pot roasts, soups and similar foods.

When the gas is lighted, the Thermodom is lowered to within two inches of the top of the range. After a few minutes it has accumulated enough of that heat which usually passes up the sides of the utensil and escapes. The gas is then turned off, the Thermodom lowered and the heat sealed in. The rest of the cooking then is done with the gas turned off and is done as quickly as if the gas were burning all of the time.

On the other special feature, the Chambers Oven, there is also construction which seals the heat in after the gas is turned off. Heat insulation on all sides and the door makes it possible to cook for as many as six hours at a time with the gas turned off.

With these features, it is possible for a housewife to start a meal with a few minutes gas, go away for the entire afternoon and return to find the meal completely cooked. So, besides saving gas, it also economizes time and effort. The confining nature of these features also keeps in the juices and flavors which ordinarily escape in the form of steam and vapor.
