No More Diving Suits?

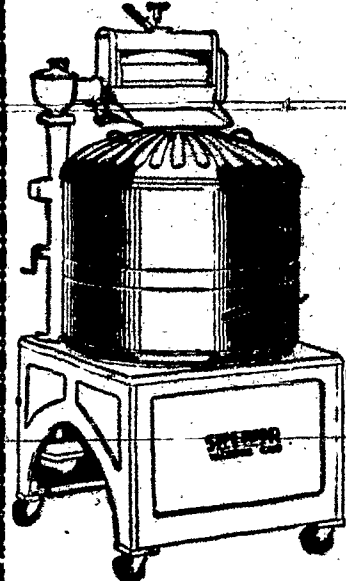
The invention by the Japanese of a diving apparatus which dispenses with the use of pumping promises to revolutionize the pearling industry.

The new apparatus consists of a small mask, with face glass and rubber edge, which covers the eyes and nose. The mask is connected to a cylinder about sixteen pounds in weight, filled with compressed air, which is carried on the chest.

The supply of air to the nose is regulated by the mouth, which controls an attachment to a tube connecting the cylinder with the mask.

The old cumbersome diving suit is thus dispensed with and the diver, with the greater freedom allowed to his limbs, can work more expeditiously.

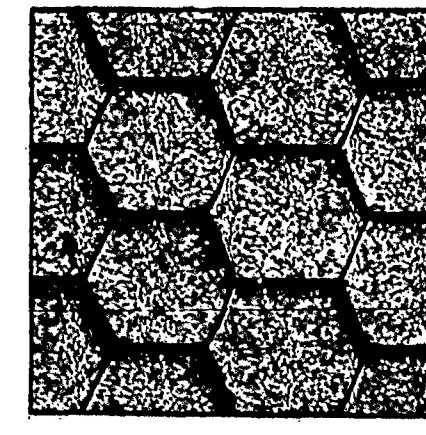
