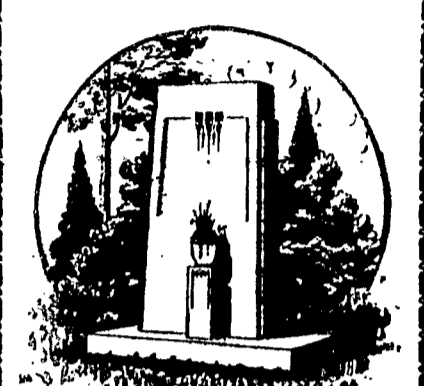

GARAGE SALES HEAVY
 Sell Number of Garages Throughout City in The Past Year.

In certain sections of the city, one may build either metal or frame garages. But in the fire district downtown, only the metal garages are allowed. In some sections, one may build a garage that will not hold over four cars, while there is no limit elsewhere.

The West Side Pattern Works secure the permit from the city for your garage and advises on the size of the garage for the location. A garage twenty feet long or over the must have a concrete foundation. At the city ordinance states, but any garage smaller than twenty feet may be set upon concrete block or any other foundation.

The above mentioned concrete foundation must be four feet deep, and it may have piers certain distances apart or it may be entirely around the building. This foundation makes the larger garages cost a little more for the foundation.

But for all the single and double garages, the West Side Pattern Works furnish concrete building blocks on which to erect the garage. These cement blocks are set flat, a little above the ground, so that the window doors will clear and so that there may be an air or breathing space under the wooden walls of the garage to preserve them.

Portable garages have 2 x 4 studs and top plates, 2 x 4 studs and rafters, just the same as the carpenter uses to build the more expensive garage that is built on the lot. On the outside of the studs a siding called novelty siding is nailed with two nails in each stud.

The roof boards are matched roof—having a tongue and groove—making a stronger roof. The roof boards may be covered with any type of roofing or shingles.

The roofing that covers the most of the portable garages and cottages is a heavy green or red colored slate surfaced roll roofing, good for many years. This same material in a shingle pattern may be had for a small extra charge.

Each garage is given one coat of white paint as priming coat to protect it for months from the weather, or until the owner decides on the color of the second coat. White paint is used so any color second coat may be applied over it.

One window comes in each side of the garage, two all together, but as each and every garage is made to order, just has your suit or overcoat, these windows may be placed wherever the customer desires them. The windows slide up and down and lock when down.

The West Side Pattern Works recommends its garage doors, as handsome a door as can be bought, made from white pine, 1.3-4 inches thick, they have six lights of glass in the top of each door, three beveled glass panels in the lower part of the door have moulded edge, the whole making a combination that can hardly be improved on. These doors are built right in their shop, held together with heavy bolts that cannot be seen from the outside of the door.

The garage door hardware on the portable garage consists of three pair heavy offset hinges, handles and latch for the center of the door, a chain bolt for the top of the door, and a foot bolt for the bottom of the door.

Portable garages and cottages can be delivered and set up miles from Rochester in small towns adjacent or along the lake shore a small extra charge being made for carting outside the city limits. Portable garages are built in sections, each side is one complete section, the roof is in four to eight sections, depending on the size of the garage. These sections come to your door loaded on a large truck and in a few hours they are bolted together and form as attractive garage as the more expensive garages nailed up on the lot. And the bolts hold more than the nails.

These garages may be made not for just one car but for a number of cars. These portable garages may be had and they may be built of frame or metal materials, whichever is preferred. The wooden garages have to be kept three feet from the lot line, while the metal garage

may be erected within six or eight inches of the line.
