

LOAN OF \$1,500,000 TO VATICAN MADE BY NEW YORK BANK

Boston, Oct. 22.—The Rt. Rev. Msgr. Eugene Burke, Rector of the North American College in Rome, left there today for further conferences with Blair & Company, the New York Banking firm, on the negotiating of a loan of \$1,500,000 to the Vatican.

Belfast Regime's Suppressive Acts Rouse Labor's Ire

Dublin, Oct. 19.—It is now apparent that in preventing the unemployed from making their peaceful demonstration, the Belfast Government has only driven the trouble underground where it may gather force for an explosion.

After the prohibition of the unemployed march, all the Labor units of Belfast immediately met and protested against the Government's action in suppressing a peaceful assembly and ignoring its right to express disapproval of the Government's economic policy.

More than one-fourth of the steadiest and most skilful workers in the Northeast area are either totally idle or on short time. The Orange workers are now adopting a conciliatory attitude toward their Catholic fellows, and seem fully alive to the injury they inflicted on the solidarity of Labor when, at the instigation of the politicians, they murderously assailed their Catholic comrades three years ago.

Six Hundred Members Of The Apostleship Of Prayer At Banquet

Cleveland, Oct. 23.—Six hundred promoters and members of the Apostleship of Prayer in the Cleveland Diocese attended the tenth annual banquet of the society at the Regatta dining pavilion here Sunday night October 18. This attendance was twice what it was last year.

In view of the increased interest in the occasion Rev. A. M. Hackert, S. J., diocesan director of the organization, intimated that next year's dinner would be held on two nights, one for those living on the east side and the other for those living on the west side.

Brescia, Oct. 18.—As the result of a movement started by the Society of the Friends of Christian Art in Italy, with the collaboration of the Beato Angelico School of Milan, a spiritual retreat for artists has been held in the house of Sant Philip, under the direction of the Philippine Fathers. This is the first retreat of the kind ever held.

Among the prominent artists making the retreat were Professor Biagetti, Director of the Vatican Galleries, Don Rescaili, Don Mario Tantarini, Don Zocche, Professors Trainini and Righeiti of the Beato Angelico School, and many others.

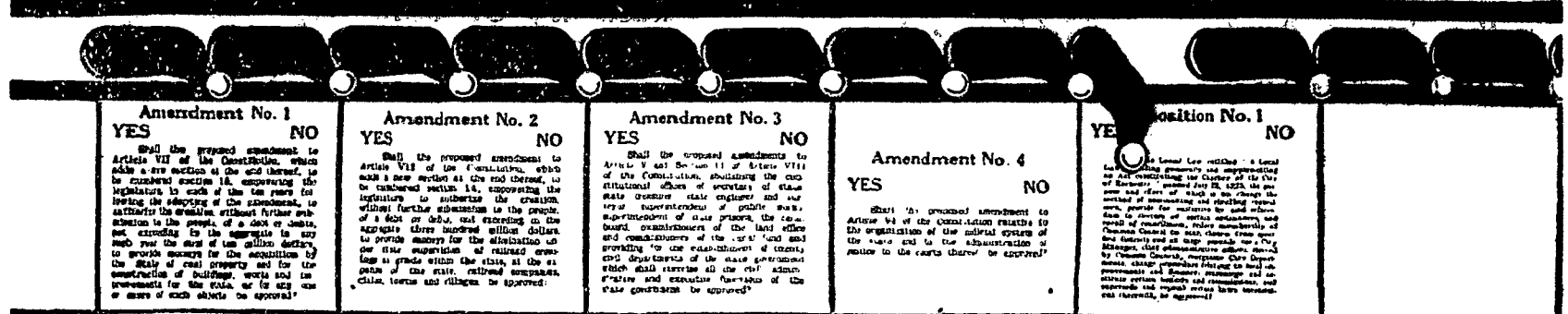
