

What It All Means

For nearly two years the eyes of Rochester have been interestingly watching the changes here at Main, North and Franklin Sts. On Franklin Street the old hotel and neighboring stores and apartments have given way to make a place for the splendid twelve-story structure which now externally, is practically completed.

The six-story Mercantile building has risen six additional stories conforming with the new construction.

In Germany the Easter fete is occadion for a five-day holiday, beginning with Greun Donnerstag and lasting ¹ through Ostern Montag.

In this country our Presidents have for many years opened the White House lawn to an egg rolling on Easter Monday, and the popularity of this affair has brought about the present vogue of municipal egg hunts.

Civic societies all over the country are beginning to stage annual egg hunts for the children of the community in the same way that the municipal Christmas tree is now a pretty fixture among civic events.


