**Four World War Veterans Become Priests Together**

London, July 16.—Four former students of the Salesian school at Battersea who served with the British army in France during the World War and afterward joined the Salesian Congregation were ordained together this week at the Basilica of Our Lady, Help of Christians, at Turin, Italy.

Father Andrew Boyle served in the Highland Light Infantry. He was captured by the Germans and treated with great severity, being compelled to work behind the firing line. Father Boyle recently obtained the degree of Doctor of Divinity.

Father Millan and Father Collinson fought together in the 2nd London Regiment. Both were decorated on the battlefield for conspicuous bravery under fire. The youngest of the newly ordained, Father Francis McCabe, served with the King's Royal Rifle. He left school to join the army.

**Military Field Mass At C. M. T. C. Post**

**Benedictine Abbot To Rule Over Two Houses in Britain**

London, July 30.—To be the ruler of two abbeys at the same time is the unusual distinction of the Rt. Rev. T. Erkenwald Egan, O.S.B., Abbot of St. Augustine's, Ramsgate, whom the Holy Father has appointed Apostolic Administrator of St. Sampson's Abbey, Caldey Island, South Wales.

In his new position Abbot Egan will have all the powers of a ruling abbot whilst still retaining the abbacy at Ramsgate. The appointment marks an important change at the island abbey. Hitherto it has had an independent existence, but it is now being affiliated to the Cassinese Congregation to which Abbot Egan and the Ramsgate community belong.

**Bishop Elect Vaughan Consecration Sept. 8**

London, July 19.—The Bishop-elect of Menevia, Canon Francis Vaughan, will be consecrated September 8th at St. David's Cathedral, Cardiff. Archbishop Mostyn of Cardiff, whose resignation from the post of Apostolic Administrator of Menevia caused the vacancy, will be the consecrating prelate.

**Belloc On Yacht As It Hits Rock**

London, July 17.—Hilaire Belloc's yacht, the Nona, ran ashore on the Capt. Rock, near Folkestone Harbor on the South Coast, this week. The famous Catholic author was aboard with two friends on a vacation cruise. Seamen from the harbor succeeded in refloating the vessel, which had run ashore at low tide. The Nona was taken into harbor, where examination showed she was not seriously damaged.

The Nona is a 9-ton cutter. One of Mr. Belloc's latest books recounts his experiences and observations aboard the boat, under the title "The Cruise of the Nona."

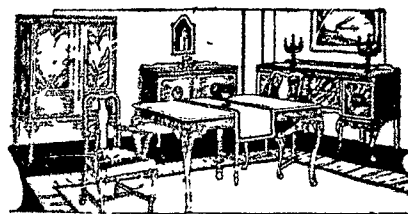
**E. L. Hearn Honored By Victor Emmanuel For Work In Rome**

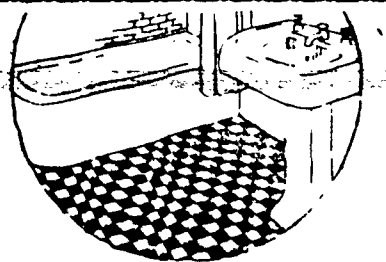
