Details Of Death Of Monks Caught By An Avalanche

News Service reported the death of three religious of the famous hospice of the great St. Bernard who were caught in an avalanche of snow in the Alps. The names of these unfortunate benefactors of humanity and the details of the accident are disclosed for the first time in the following dispatch from Rome.

Rome, Jan. 3.-Louis Luisier, Leo Breataz and Eugene Bonvin, young Swiss who would have been ordained to the priesthood this year, were the three members of the hospice of the great Saint Bernard who died after being smothered and battered in an avalanche of Alpine snow some weeks

Thirteen of the religious began the fatal excursion on skis, it has been reveated, and five of these were caught in the speeding mass of snow and rocks and hurled into the valley 500 meters from where they were entrapped. All of these were dug out unconscious, but only the first two extricated survived. Superhuman efforts, tenderness and care failed to save the last three.

A servant at the hospice declares that at what is thought to have been the very moment at which the avalanche descended, the dogs, famed assistants of the Monks in their rescue work, howled piteously in their kennels. "The history of bells in our Catholic churches goes very far back into the past. It is a proud boast for us in Irelandand it can be said with substantial truth-that the custom of having bells attached to our churches, has its origin in the early Irish Church. In the oldest times in Ireland, each saint had its special bell, by means of which he summoned the people to prayer. The oldest ell in Ireland is the Bell of Saint Patrick.

"In that olden time,a Saint's bell was considered one of the most precious things of the Church. When a person wanted to take an oath, he swor it on the belt of the saint. When armies marched into battle. they carried the Saint's bell with them. In times of difficulties and danger, these bells were kept in the round towers, which thus came to be used as belfries. When our Irish missionaries went abroad to spread the light of faith over the continent of Europe, they brought with them the custom of having bells rung, to call the people to prayer.
