Fr. Ricard Takes Issue With U.S. Weather Bureau

(By N. C. W. C. News Service) San Francisco, June 3.-Father Jerome S. Ricard, S. J., the famous "Padre of the Rains" of Santa Clara University, has taken sharp issue with the United States Weather Burcase on two of its recent statements. They are that the next sunspot maximum will occur next year, and that there is no proof of a connection hetween the period of the sunspot meximum and storms which have been sweeping the earth. The "Padre" also ridicules the Bureau's opinions on longrange weather forecasting.


