diplomatic corps attended a high mass celebrated by the Papal Nuncio. Members of 55 Catholic societies were among the congregation.

On that occasion, after explaining the objects of the society, His Eminence suggested that as a further means of showing their loyalty to the Holy Father, the Catholics of this country should follow the example set by Catholics in other European countries of commemorating in a special way the anniversary of the coronation of the Sovereign Pontiff.
