Letter of Sympathy From Scots Bishops Reaches Msgr. Diaz

(By N. C. W. O. News Service)
New York, May 24.—The Rt. Rev. Pascual Diaz, Bishop of Tobacco and secretary of the Mexican hierarchy, has received the text of the expression of sympathy for the Archbishop and Bishops and the people of Mexico voted by members of the Scotch episcopate three weeks ago.
The letter to Bishop Diaz is signed by the Most Rev. George H. Bennett, Bishop of Aberdeen, and is as follows:
"My dear Lord Bishop,
"The Scottish Hierarchy, at a meeting held in Edinburgh on the 3rd of May, instructed me to convey to Lord Cardinal Diaz, and through you to the Archbishops and Bishops of Mexico, an expression of their deepest sympathy with your Lordship, your Clergy and faithful people in your present sufferings, and an assurance of our constant prayers for the Almighty hand of God the Father's persecution you are so bravely enduring may soon come to an end."
"I am to add that with this intention we have ordered a special Collect to be inserted in the Mass throughout our respective Dioceses."
"With the assurance of my personal sympathy, and with kindest regards,
"Believe me,
"Yours very sincerely in Christ
"George H. Bennett
"Bishop of Aberdeen and Secretary to the Scottish Hierarchy."
This is one of many such expressions that have come from the Scotch Hierarchy and its Bishops.

missions. The same influence is also felt in other communities, though not to the extent that the Spanish missions of California have influenced architecture in that State. That is no doubt due to the fact that California was more alert than Texas to appreciate its mission and take steps for their preservation, though the Texas missions are considered artistically more arresting than those in the Pacific coast State. . . .
"It may be taken for granted that the term 'restoration' does not contemplate anything which would detract from the mellow flavor of antiquity surrounding the venerable buildings. The project should be entrusted, as it doubtless will be, to an architect who would bring to the assignment sympathetic understanding of the missions as something more than edifices of stone and mortar."
"Texas should appreciate the service being undertaken by the Knights of Columbus, and if an opportunity offered the citizenship at large, to furnish financial assistance we have no doubt it will be cheerfully extended."
