Why "Eve's Apple Tree"

Among the many botanical curiosities of Ceylon is a fruit supposed to bear the marks of Eve's teeth!

The tree on which it grows is known by the significant mame of "Forbidden Fruit," or "Eve's Apple Tree." The blossom is pleasantly scented, and the truit is orange in coler satside and a deep crimson within. Hach fruit has the peculiar appearance of having a plece bitten out of it.

This fact, together with its poison ous quality, led to the belief that it was the forbidden fruit of the Garden of Eden, and serves the useful purpess of warning such as might be tempted by its lovely appearance to imitate Eve and take a bite.

Old Monarchical Idea The name "Divine Right of Kings" is given to a doctrine that was promulgated in England in the Seventeenth century. It asserted that kings held their authority by divine Bochester, R. Y. appointment and were earthly representatives of the Delty.
