Benefits Of Mission Recognized By China

(By N. C. W. C. News Service) Kiangsi, China, Aug. 24.—A distinct change in the attitude toward the Church in this vicinity has come about in the last three months. General Lion, principal representative of the government, has issued orders prohibiting propaganda against the missionaries and has assured the Catholics full freedom of conscience. A statement he has just issued declares that the purpose of the revolution was to improve the condition of the people and that the missions have a definite status in the province. The most remarkable change is in the tone of the native press which has withdrawn its arguments against the Catholic missionaries. Church property in Anhwei is still under confiscation, although it is understood that orders had been issued from Nanking that it was to be released.

Osservatore Romano Backs Kellogg Pact

Rome, August.—The Osservatore Romano has published a long article on the Kellogg pact to out-law war in which it approves the project of the American Secretary of State. It says, in part: "Another war would be the end of Europe, situated as it is between two adverse forces—American plutocracy and Russian bolshevism. The pact against war has been proposed at the proper moment and has every chance of success because European nations are desirous of preserving peace on every hand. "It is probable that acceptances will be made on the Kellogg project but those are persons ridiculed the League of Nations which nevertheless is now engaged in interesting work. "When Secretary Kellogg first presented his plan to outlaw war, it was thought in some circles that he was organizing a vast plot to undermine the League of Nations. It is evident, to the contrary, that whereas the pact is different from the Covenant they both lead to the same end. It is easy to mock these American efforts, but a condition of continual contact between the leaders of different nations can only augment fraternity of nations and must, of necessity, further peace."

Californians To Fete Pulaski Anniversary

News Service) Sacramento, Cal., Aug. 24.—California will celebrate the 150th anniversary of the death of Brigadier General Casimir Pulaski, Catholic Revolutionary War hero, on October 11, 1929, according to a resolution being prepared here for the 1929 session of the legislature. General Pulaski won distinction in the Battle of Brandywine and was made a brigadier general of the Continental army. Two years later he was killed at the siege of Savannah. Under the terms of a resolution the governor would call upon California to display the flag on the anniversary date and would establish a Pulaski sesquicentennial committee to arrange the celebration.
