Catholic Railwaymen Plan Guild In England

London, Oct. 30.—A Guild of Catholic Railwaymen is in prospect here. Cardinal Bourne made casual reference to this new development when he addressed the Catholic Nurses' Guild at the end of the first year of its existence. "We are living in an age of guilds," said the Cardinal. "We have a very flourishing police guild, a busmen's guild has been proposed, and there is, I believe, a railwaymen's guild in prospect. Addressing the nurses, His Eminence said: "Your calling is a very holy and a very sacred one; you are carrying out in a very practical manner one of the greatest works of mercy."

Guild of Nurses Adopt A Program

Washington, Nov. 1.—The International Catholic Guild of Nurses is holding a number of regional meetings of Sisters interested in its program. Those held during late September and early October, include meetings at Chicago, Illinois; Freeport, Illinois; Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and Montreal, Canada. Attendance at each of these meetings was large and included not only the Superintendents and Superintendents of Nurses of the local hospitals, but a wide representation of hospital Sisters from the surrounding country. At all of these conferences the interests of the Catholic Nursing Schools were discussed, and Father Garesche announced that the Guild would hereafter function as a federation of the alumnae associations of Catholic Nursing Schools, to work for the interests of these schools, as well as for the benefit of individual members. All the Sisters present pledged their support, and will do their utmost to further the activities of the Guild. The program to be developed this year includes: Federation of the alumnae of all the Catholic Nursing Schools; publication of a monthly magazine to be sent gratis to all its members; development of the Bureau of Nursing Opportunity; the annual convention, to be held July 5, 6 and 7 at Montreal, Canada; a Scholarship Fund; numerous other social and educational features.

Caldey Monks Move To Prinknash Park

London, Oct. 31. — The Caldey monks, who are moving to Prinknash Park, Gloucester, will maintain connection with their history by calling their home "New Caldey Abbey." A statement issued with the new issue of Pax, the community's magazine, says, in part: "In the last number of Pax, we spoke of the possibility to help from the United States and of our hopes of being able to remain on the island which has been our home for so long. These hopes have not been realized, and it is now become necessary for us to leave Caldey and begin our life afresh at Prinknash Park, near Gloucester."

Mission At Seattle Plans New School

Seattle, Nov. 2.—Plans are under way at the Maryknoll Mission here to erect a new chapel and school to replace the present wooden structure. From small beginnings in 1920, when at the request of the Rt. Rev. Bishop for some one to care for the Japanese, two Sisters opened a kindergarten, the mission has continued a steady growth. The second, third and fourth grades have been added, and the study of Japanese included in the curriculum. One hundred and fifty Japanese children attend the kindergarten and school. A Japanese Conference of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, the first in the United States, has just been organized. Since the founding of the mission it has had two vocations—one to the priesthood and one to the Sisters.

St. Mary's Teacher Finds Prehistoric Footprint In Rock

St. Mary's, Cal., Nov. 2.—During a stroll along the slope of Moraga Valley, not far from St. Mary's College Brother Vantasion came upon pre-historic footprints of some gigantic beast, probably a mastodon. The rock stratum containing the prints was uncovered by a steam shovel at work on the construction of a county road. R. A. Sturton, curator of the vertebrate collection in the department of paleontology in the University of California, when called to the scene, announced the footprints would furnish an interesting study into paleontological research. The prints will be preserved.
