More than 165,000 students attend parochial schools in Chicago. The enrollment in the Catholic high schools, colleges and seminaries exceeds 200,000.

Blackstone, Va., Nov. 16. — Responding to an alarm here at 2 a. m., Wednesday, firemen discovered that the blaze was the burning of an effigy of Bishop James Cannon, Jr. Blackstone is the home town of the Southern Methodist church who campaigned against Governor Smith in the recent election. On the blazing effigy, which had been strung up to a tree and then set fire to, was affixed a tag with the inscription: "The Fourth district is solid for Democracy. We will not be ruled by the pope of Virginia." Although the birth place of Bishop Cannon, Blackstone went Democratic three to one.

Mass To Be Sung In Puritan Church

New Haven, Nov. 17.—Tomorrow, probably for the first time in a Connecticut Protestant church, a Mass will be sung here in Centre Church, a stronghold of Puritanism for nearly 300 years. Following the lecture the Boys' choir of St. Anthony's church gave a concert. The Sisters of the Holy Family, founded in San Francisco in 1872 by Elizabeth Arner, under the direction of the Very Rev. P. J. Prendergast, instruct neglected children for the sacraments, care for young children of working women and conduct classes in religion.

Father F. J. Brune, Iowa Pastor, Dies

Alton, Ia., Nov. 16.—Funeral services for the Very Rev. Frederick J. Brune, for 34 years pastor of St. Mary's Church here, were held yesterday. Father Brune died Sunday evening. Born in Neunkirchen, Oldenburg, Germany, Dec. 9, 1856, he was ordained at Dubuque, July 14, 1884. Alton boasts one of the largest Catholic churches and properties in the state, consisting of a large church, school and parish hall, the value of the property amounting to \$200,000. Chiefly through the efforts of Father Brune, it was entirely cleared of debt in 1924.
