Former Governor Smith Honored as Outstanding Catholic Citizen

of doing homage to the most worthy of her faith and nationhood, has named you, sir, as the recipient of her most cherished distinction, to which, in turn, the full measure of your deserving will but add new lustre.

In recognition of signal devotion to faith and country, in consideration of personal worth as a public official and as a private citizen, the University of Notre Dame asks you, Alfred Emmanuel Smith, to accept the Lactare Medal for this year of Our Lord, nineteen hundred twenty nine. May you wear it unto length of days in the serene enjoyment that comes from the consciousness of work well done and in the peace of heart that is the fruitage of that faith in which a man "has tried to walk humbly with his God."

Tribute by Cardinal Hayes. Cardinal Hayes planned the Lactare medal upon Governor Smith's breast and then paid him this beautiful tribute:

The University Honored. "No more happy privilege could come to me than the honor of placing on your breast the notable distinction of the Lactare Medal, conferred by a great, noble, Catholic school of learning, the University of Notre Dame. I congratulate rather the university than I do you, because I feel that the university is singularly honored by your acceptance, and has had a rare opportunity to demonstrate the wisdom, the courage, the culture, and the patriotism that motivate its councils.

To the impressive roster of distinguished Catholic men and women whose names are synonymous with notable achievement in science, art, letters, statecraft and industry, your own illustrious name is added, to the intense satisfaction and supreme joy of us all.

"May I say that the list of Lactare Medalists would be, indeed, far from complete were Notre Dame to fail to recognize the lustre—the unique

lustre—which radiates from your nobility of character, your charming personality, your remarkable example in government, your outstanding service in public life and, above all, your inspiring loyalty to your God and your country.

His Spirited Inspiration. "It is not often granted, my dear Governor, to statesmen to fire with spiritual inspiration the hearts of millions as you have done. This is even a greater gift than the power to fascinate the imagination of a nation, or even to compel the admiration of a people—both of which history will record that you accomplished.

"As the shepherd of the fold to which you render spiritual allegiance, I gladly and proudly acclaim you tonight before all men for the exalted principles, religious and civic, that have guided you in private and public life. These principles are born of God—and not of man. You have been an inspiration to me by your Christian example, for which I praise our Heavenly Father. "Your loyalties, human, civic, spiritual, are those of the great and the good. Most happily united in your person are goodness and greatness. You could not be otherwise than loyal to all that is true and noble, human and divine.

Faith Helped Loyalty. "Never have you turned your back on the hearthstone where you were reared, nor even now do you forget the graves where are interred the revered ashes of your beloved parents. Never have you looked upon your home and family except as a sanctuary where God's holy law should prevail. Never have you failed your God in worship at the altars of our fathers in the faith. Never has your fidelity to your Creator and Saviour impaired, or even diminished, your loyalty to your country. Yea, rather, your spiritual allegiance has ennobled and enhanced with greater zeal and devotion the splendor of your patriotism. The cross which over illumines your soul unfolds to your mind and heart the flag of our beloved land in the light of eternal beauty, glory and benediction that man cannot give, but comes from God alone.

"Little wonder then that you have been so highly favored before God and honored and beloved among men. "American citizen, American statesman, Christian gentleman, noble friend, faithful follower of the Divine Master—beloved of us all—may God ever bless you.

President Hoover's Greeting. Hon. Herbert Hoover, President of the United States, sent the following telegram to Father O'Donnell, President of the University: The Rev. Charles L. O'Donnell, President, the University of Notre Dame.

My dear Dr. O'Donnell: I have your letter of the 22d, informing me that the Lactare Medal from the University of Notre Dame will on the 5th of May be awarded to Governor Alfred E. Smith.

I am glad you have thus given me the opportunity to join in congratulations to Governor Smith for the honor which you confer upon so distinguished an American and to the university for its public spirit in honoring so great a public servant.

Twenty-nine Years Married. Mrs. Smith was visibly stirred by the applause which greeted the award of the medal to her husband. With her children she witnessed the ceremony from the balcony of the hotel ballroom. She and the Governor celebrated the twenty-ninth anniversary of their marriage on the following night, Monday.

The Governor Grateful. In thanking Cardinal Hayes and the Reverend President of Notre Dame University, Governor Smith also expressed appreciation of the congratulations of President Hoover.

The principal address of the event was given by Dr. Frank P. Graves, President of the University of the State of New York and State Commissioner of Education. Dr. Graves paid eloquent tribute to the honesty, efficiency, ability and integrity of Governor Smith.

Altogether it was a notable occasion, emphasizing not only the civic and patriotic elements of Governor Smith's work, but his sterling Catholicity and unflinching loyalty to the faith he loves.

CALIFORNIA WOMAN LEAVES FORTUNE TO CHARITIES

Los Angeles, April 18.—Four Catholic institutions are to benefit under the will of Clara Baldwin Stocker, daughter of "Lucky" Baldwin, recently filed for probate. Among 13 institutions that are to share thirteen and one-third per cent of the estate are Convent of the Good Shepherd, Los Angeles Orphan Asylum, Regina Coeli Orphan Asylum and St. Vincent's Hospital. Each of these institutions will receive approximately \$150,000.

Twenty per cent of the estate goes to build in Los Angeles County, a home for Caucasian Protestant women more than 50 years of age who are incapacitated.

In specifying that the home be for Protestant women only, Mrs. Stocker says in her will that it is "for the reason that there are many very wealthy Catholic and Jewish residents of Los Angeles County who can and will, I believe, provide similar charities for such elderly women of their own respective faiths and because there seems to be more and better organized charities in Los Angeles County among those professing the Catholic and Jewish faiths, respectively, than among those professing the Protestant faith."
