Seventy Accredited Schools Offering Summer Courses This Year

80 Colleges Will Conduct Summer Schools

Many Thousands of Students Will Attend Catholic Institutions This Year

INCREASE EXPECTED OVER THE PAST YEAR

Preponderance of Students Will Be Religious Teachers—Schools in This State

Washington, June 6.—A total of 80 Catholic colleges and universities will offer summer courses this year, a survey just completed by the Department of Education of the National Catholic Welfare Conference here reveals.

In 1928 the Department's records show, only 60 such educational centers offered summer courses. The courses were attended by a total of 16,039 students, of whom 2,089 were men and 13,950 women.

Since 20 more colleges and universities are this year offering summer courses and since virtually every one of last year's summer school centers is looking forward to increased enrollments this year, it is regarded as almost certain that last year's total enrollment will be far exceeded this summer.

New York, June 6.—Arrangements have been completed for the eighty-fourth commencement exercises of Fordham University which will be held from June 8 to 12.

More than 1,100 degrees will be conferred upon graduates of the various departments, of which 450 are from the School of Law and the remainder from the College of Arts and Sciences and Graduate School and Schools of Social Science and Business Administration. There will be no graduation in the College of Pharmacy this year as their course of studies was changed from two to three years.

For the graduating class a retreat will be given in the University Chapel by the Rev. John A. Cotter, S. J., June 6-8.

Catholic Youths Reveal Qualities Desired in Wives

St. Louis, June 6.—Qualities that American high school and college boys of Catholic faith expect to find in their future wives are summarized in the May issue of The Queen's Work, edited by the Rev. Daniel A. Lord, S. J., of St. Louis University. The article is the first of a series which will set forth the results of a questionnaire sent to thousands of Catholic students throughout the country.

Twenty-five per cent of the college men and 23 per cent of the high school students stated that they preferred the old-fashioned girl to the modern flapper. Some typical student comments on various feminine qualities follow:

"I want a Catholic girl who goes to church, not to show off her clothes, but because it is her duty."
 "One who receives Communion at least once a month."
 "A girl who does not drink, swear nor smoke—a non-alcoholic girl."
 "A girl with an education equal to mine, though not superior to mine."
 "One with home training, whose education was not acquired at the dance hall or the theater."

During the last few years shingles have been used to a very excellent advantage for the outside walls of modern frame homes. They make an attractive exterior for the reason that they may be had in colors, or the silver gray which is reminiscent of the homes which have been weather-beaten by the salt ocean air. It is this silver appearance that makes the homes along the Atlantic seacoast so attractive.

second floor provides a deeply recessed porch and gives to the house the appearance of greater size than it really is.

The dimensions of the home are 24 by 28 feet. On the first floor are a large living room, a dining room and kitchen with a breakfast nook between the kitchen and dining room. On the second floor are three large bedrooms and bathroom.

How these rooms are arranged and their sizes are shown on the floor plans which accompany the exterior view of the house. It will be noted that the living room extends practically the width of the house, with the exception of space for the entrance hall and the stairs leading to the second floor. Back of the living room is the dining room and to the right are the breakfast nook and kitchen. The steep pitch of the roof is broken by a dormer at the front which permits space for double windows for each of the front bedrooms, while another window on either side permits excellent ventilation.

How attractive this home can be made when surrounded by plantings of shrubs and flowers is shown in the illustration.


