MASSES FOR WEEK

By the Rev. Paul G. Brissard

(There is only one oration unless otherwise directed. The Gloria and Creed are said only when so directed.)

Sept. 1. The 15th day after Pentecost. Green vestments. Mass is proper to the Sunday. Gloria. Commemorate St. Giles and then the martyrs of the same day. Creed. Preface of the Trinity.

Sept. 2. Monday. Feast of St. Stephen. White vestments. Mass is proper to the feast. The 2nd oration is of all the Saints. The priest may choose the 3rd. A votive Mass is permitted.

Sept. 3. Tuesday. Mass is of last Sunday without the Gloria and Creed. The 2nd oration is of all the Saints. The 3rd is for the dead, the 4th is left to the priest to choose. A votive Mass is permitted.

Sept. 4. Wednesday. Mass is the same as yesterday. A votive Mass is permitted.

Sept. 5. Thursday. Feast of St. Lawrence. White vestments. Mass is proper to the feast. Gloria. The 2nd oration is of all the Saints, the priest may choose the 3rd. A votive Mass is permitted.

Sept. 6. Friday. Mass may be of last Sunday as it was on last Tuesday. Green vestments; or it may be the Votive Mass of the Sacred Heart. (White vestments) with the Gloria and Creed and the Preface of the Cross. Any other votive Mass is permitted.

Sept. 7. Saturday. Votive Mass of the Blessed Virgin for the Saturdays after Pentecost, beginning "Hail, holy Parent." The 2nd oration is of the Holy Ghost, the 3rd for the Church or for the Pope. Gloria. Preface of the Blessed Virgin.
