Elmira Will Celebrate Seventy-Fifth Anniversary On Sunday, Sept. 8th
Donoghue. During Father Gibbons' pastorate many improvements were made in the church and the rectory. In 1896 the Rev. John C. Long succeeded Father Gibbons. In 1897, the parishes of Chemung County were assigned to the care of the Rochester Diocese, under the Bishop of the Diocese. The years Right Rev. Bernard McQuaid, first of Father Long's pastorate were fruitful of great results. The present parochial school was built by him, the marble altar railing was installed in the church, the beautiful Crucifixion group was placed in the cemetery, a large plot of land, adjoining the cemetery was secured, and the interior of the church was frescoed. Shortly after the church had been rededicated, a disastrous fire destroyed the frescoes and decorations. Rev. John J. Lee Named Pastor In 1916 Father Long was called to his eternal reward, and the Rev. John J. Lee, pastor of Watkins Glen parish, was appointed as his successor. Under Father Lee's guidance...

the spiritual welfare of the parish has been thinking, and he has been responsible for many improvements of the parochial property and the cemetery. The school building which had been erected by Father Cunningham has been converted into an apartment house and in 1927 a new parish hall was completed. At the present time, due to the transfer of the present convent property to St. Joseph's Hospital, Father Lee is busily engaged in remodeling and equipping the house on East Market Street, directly east of the parochial residence, as a new convent for the Sisters who teach in the parish school. When the improvements are completed, this convent will be modern and up-to-date in every respect. Thus, during the seventy-five years which have elapsed since the cornerstone of the present church was laid, many improvements and changes have been made in the parochial property, due to the zealous leadership of the earnest priests who have guided the destinies of the parish, with the hearty co-operation of people filled with the spirit of self-sacrifice and devotion to high and noble ideals.
