**Soviets Send
A Chief Rabbi
To 10 Years Exile**

Moscow, April 18.—Rabbi Lazarev, chief rabbi of Leningrad, who was arrested February 26, with Rabbi Yanogorowski by the Russian secret police on a charge that they had been maintaining illegal connections abroad, was sentenced last week to ten years' exile in a concentration camp.

Rabbi Lazarev's son was expelled for three years, while the beadle, Zemach Zedek, was expelled for two years. The fourteen members of the Leningrad Jewish community, who had been arrested for disobeying the regulations laid down with regard to religious communities, also were expelled to a concentration camp for various periods of years. These sentences have caused great indignation among the Jews.

ALMOST A PRIEST

The following letter, recently received by Rev. Leo Mooney, Diocesan director of the Propagation of the Faith Society, tells its own story:

"Many of the old Northern Cheyennes of Montana are still pagan. But they can be won to the Church. Many of the children are unbaptized. But they can be instructed. The sick and the old Indians have to be looked after. The missionaries are too few to do all that needs to be done. Such work requires the faithful services of an interpreter and catechist. He is almost a priest in the work he does for souls. We can not get more priests. We easily find good Indian catechists. Two large districts, Lamedeer and Busby, could be looked after by one catechist in steady service. He ought to have enough to live on and keep his family, but I think \$40 a month would satisfy such a man. In Birney there is a similar need. Without such a helper, our work is hampered. It would discourage any missionary. Can you find a friend or friends who will co-operate with us by sending us help to pay a catechist the small wage of \$40 a month?"
